## Petition to the House of Commons

Whereas:

- The European Union has banned the cloning of farm animals to protect humans and to prevent animal cruelty.
- There are no human safety studies on cloned meat to demonstrate cloned meat is safe to consume. There are insufficient animal safety studies to demonstrate cloned meat is safe to consume.
- Cloned meat is prone to unpredictable genetic and anatomical defects.
- Cloned animals require more hormones, antibiotics and other drugs than naturally conceived animals. Cloned meat has higher levels of hormones, antibiotics and other drugs which poses a danger to human health.
- The cloning of farm animals creates unnecessary and unacceptable animal suffering.
- There are no benefits to humans from eating cloned meat instead of naturally bred meat. There are only risks to humans from eating cloned meat.
- The Citizens and Residents of Canada do not want cloned meat in the food supply.

- Health Canada has signalled that it will allow cloned meat to be consumed. Canadians should not be consuming cloned meat. Without a ban by Parliament, cloned meat will be allowed into the Canadian food supply.
- The Citizens and Residents of Canada need protection from Health Canada.

We, the undersigned, **Citizens (or Residents) of Canada**, call upon the **House of Commons** to (1) ban the cloning of farm animals; (2) ban the import of cloned farm animals and products from cloned farm animals, and (3) ban the consumption of cloned meat and products from cloned animals.
