On March 12, 2026, a petition calling on the Government to enact the *Charter of Health Freedom* was tabled in Parliament. My understanding is that this is the third largest paper petition certified by the Clerk of Petitions to be tabled in the House of Commons in our history. This is the largest paper petition to be tabled in Parliament since 1966.

The petition supporting *the Charter of Health Freedom* is impressive because it was a citizen initiative. There was no support by political parties or big organizations. ***This is the largest grass-roots paper petition in our history!***

This is the largest grass-roots petition in Canadian history because having reasonable access to natural health products is a matter of life and death. Canadians are fed up with Health Canada treating our natural remedies like dangerous drugs. Canadians are fed up with vital nutrients and remedies being illegal unless approved of by Health Canada. Canadians are fed up with the censorship of truthful health information caused by natural products being classified as drugs.

The Government needs to respond to the petition. ***I want you to ensure that the Government responds by enacting the Charter of Health Freedom.***

The *Charter of Health Freedom*:

Codifies the health rights the Courts already say we have;

1. Requires a balanced risk analysis in the regulation of natural and traditional remedies. For the first time in Canadian history our regulator would be required to act in the best interest of the health of Canadians;
2. Create the Ministry of Wellness to protect and to promote access to natural and traditional remedies;
3. Creates a Health Ombudsman to protect vulnerable Canadians from dangerous bureaucratic overreach, and
4. Frees natural and traditional remedies from needing government pre-approval. The same products do not need government pre-approval in the U.S. The recent requirement in Canada for Health Canada approval has been a disaster for Canadians and Canadian businesses. Our products are not demonstrably safer than the same products in the U.S. The only difference is our products are more expensive which takes them away from low income Canadians. This is discrimination.
